VP OF FUNDRAISING REPORT:

Amy reviewed how successful the Check-a-Thon was this year following a Covid year. All the prizes have been given out. \$48,000 going back to the school and \$5,800 going to the teachers as their 10% back to the classroom.

Popcorn Fundraiser – Amy reviewed the popcorn fundraiser she has done for years to sell Double Good popcorn – 50% goes back to the school. All self-contained on-line and no extra work for delivery or pick-up needed. This fundraiser is being done in case the carnival is not possible.

VP OF MEMBERSHIP REPORT:

Julie gave quick update on membership. Still missing a couple teachers and with their participation, we would get an award for 100% participation.

COORESPONDING SECRETARY:

Carol received praise for her newsletter.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Amisha reviewed the budget changes that are proposed in order to allocate the funds received from Check-a-Thon. \$48,000 to gift back to the school after all expenses are paid. Also adjusted the CAMP classes to pull those funds out to their own line items going forward. This way their funds are not tied to a specific fundraising event. Finally, under hospitality the funds for the regular Veterans Day event were moved to general hospitality since the Veterans Day event did not happen. Floor was opened for questions, none were asked. Vote was held and the revised Budget passed with 13 votes.
